### Aims

'Dressing For Your Day'

The aim of the dress code is to dress professionally, comfortably and prepare for the world of work.

How we show up to school is an expression of ourselves, our values, our professionalism and our intent. What we wear and our general appearance is a part of that.

Students are permitted to choose their own clothing (in line with the guidance below).

- Smart shorts, skirts and dresses may be worn.
- The length must be no higher than six inches above the top of the kneecap when standing and walking, must not have holes that expose skin or undergarments more than six inches above the kneecap and most not expose skin or undergarments above the waistband.
- Shorts, Skirts and dresses should not be excessively tight fitting. If a skirt or dress has a slit, the slit must meet the same guidelines (no more than six inches above the top of the kneecap).
- Shorts must be worn at the waist. If a belt is needed to hold shorts up, one must be worn.
- Trousers must not be excessively tight-fitting or expose skin more than six inches above the top of the kneecap.
- Underwear must not be visible.
- If a belt is needed to hold trousers up, one must be worn.
- Shirts/tops must cover the midriff, waist, back and cleavage and must not be excessively tight fitting or see through.

The following items are **not permitted** to be worn in school:

- Ripped jeans
- Stockings
- Corsets
- Ripped tights
- Sliders, slippers or flip-flops
- Short tops showing midriff
- Excessively short clothing (shorts, skirts, dresses etc.)
- Clothing representing drugs, tobacco, alcohol, sex, gang violence or crude, suggestive or divisive in words or pictures

## **Safeguarding**

Students must wear their lanyard at all times when in the building

On the occasion of special events or visitors, students will be excepted to dress in smart attire in order to represent the school.
